Policies and Procedures on Education Assistance

The purpose of Education Assistance is to encourage Christian education in an Adventist institution and to help the needy students financially.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Application Deadline
 - Submit your application to CMI Board chairman by June 30 each year. Any late submission will not be accepted.
 - Scholarships are awarded for a one-year term and reviewed annually.
2. Required Documents
 - Applicants must provide their current transcript and a personal statement.
3. Recommendation Letters
 - Include two recommendations:
 - ✓ One from an SDA pastor
 - ✓ One from either a teacher or a mentor
4. Financial Support
 - Scholarships cover:
 - ✓ Up to \$1,500 per year for tuition
 - ✓ Up to \$500 for living expenses.
 - Funding is available for full-time academic year
5. Academic Level
 - Open to students with proficiency in the Chinese language pursuing graduate or undergraduate degrees at SDA institutions in Asia.
6. Ministry Involvement
 - Applicants must be studying or training for roles as theology majors with future intentions to minister in Chinese communities.
7. Academic Standing
 - Students must maintain a GPA of at least a B or above.
8. CMI Board Oversight
 - Scholarships are intended for on campus and full-time study.
 - Final decisions, including exceptions, are made at the discretion of the CMI board during their annual meeting.
